# **Fund Manager's comment**

## Performance

Adrigo Hedge rose by 0.63% in July, net of fees.

The holdings which contributed the most to the Fund's performance were Recipharm (pharmaceutical manufacturing) and Getinge (medtech). Among the smaller positions, Husqvarna (forest and garden products) and SEB (banks) and posted good contributions. The Fund's short positions did in aggregate impact returns negatively.

Adrigo Hedge has returned 55.1% since inception, adjusted for dividends. In the same period the benchmark STIBOR 1M has returned 14.44% and the OMX N40 index has risen by 53.7%.

## **Market Comment**

The Nordic large cap index OMX N40 rose by 3.5% in July.

In July, most Nordic corporates reported their results for the second quarter. Analyst estimates had been substantially downgraded before the reports. Overall, the results have been above expectations as governmental support programs and larger, potentially temporary cost savings were contributing factors why earnings were better than expected. We noted overall positive share price reactions although automotive exposed entities stood out as overly negative.

The USD has continued to weaken against the EUR but also the SEK. This will eventually put pressure on Swedish industrials' earnings. SEK has also strengthened against EUR during Q2 and is now in-line on a year over year basis.

### Outlook

At the time of the writing, the Nordic earnings season for Q2 is soon coming to an end. It is very clear that we had too low expectations on company earnings. According to investment bank Carnegie, Nordic earnings fell by 46% y-o-y but nevertheless beat consensus expectations by 16%. Sales fell by 16% which was also better than expected. Many companies experienced a strong rebound in sales in June after the very weak April and May. Lower costs stemming from government grants, lower travel costs and overall strong cost control had significant impact.

Several of our holdings posted surprisingly strong results. Especially we would like to highlight Getinge, BillerudKorsnäs and Electrolux. In all of these stocks, we see very interesting potential also in the longer perspective.

Parts of Getinge's business areas have been very positively impacted by Covid-19, particularily demand for advanced respiratory equipment sky-rocketed. To some extent the increase should be seen as a one-off. However, there are signals that the long-term demand for this kind of equipment will increase as hospitals clearly have underinvested for a long period. Our thesis is that Getinge will be able to close a significant part of the margin gap towards its competitors. We believe that this will lead to a multiple expansion, indicating good potential for further appreciation of the share price.

Given the uncertainty we see in the global macro picture we continue to focus our investments on companies which earnings development is more dependent on internal measures than the overall macro development.
